History

Built in 1912, the historic hotel opened around the same time the Panama Canal came into existence.

The historic Panama Hotel was built to serve rail passengers. It is located next to the old Santa Fe Train Station, which is now Galveston's Railroad Museum.

At construction it boasted 103 guest rooms. The four story building which has been vacant for decades, comprises roughly 28,000 square feet.
